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Kaiser Named Top Quality Health Plan In Colorado Regaining Top Rank From CIGNA

- 2) CIGNA - 83.9 points and ranked #72 (#55)
- 3) UnitedHealthcare of CO - 82.7 points and ranked #110 (#77)
- 4) Aetna Health - CO - 82.6 points and ranked #112 (#146)
- 5) PacifiCare of Colorado - 81.9 and ranked #140 (#139)
- 6) HMO Colorado - 80.2 points and ranked #182 (#188)
- 7) Rocky Mountain Health Plans - 66.9 points and ranked #228 (#235),
- 8) Denver Health Medical Plan - 61.4 points and ranked #236 (#246)

This year's ranked Colorado Medicare plans are shown below with their 2008 score and ranking along with their 2007 rank:

- 1) Kaiser - 87.1 points and ranked #8 (#13)
- 2) PacifiCare of CO - 82.6 points and ranked #58 (#50)
- 3) Rocky Mountain Health Plans - 67.7 points and ranked #104 (#102)

This year's ranked Colorado Medicaid plans are shown below with their 2008 score and ranking along with their 2007 rank:

- 1) Rocky Mountain Health Plans - 72.1 points and ranked #66 (#63),
- 2) Denver Health Medical Plan - 69.4 points and ranked #70 (#67).
